1. Please give a brief overview of the assessment data you collected this year.


The RN-BSN Nursing Program focused its review on Program Outcome 5 again this year. Student performance was satisfactory.

2. How will you use what you've learned from the data that was collected?

Changes in the program that resulted from the program assessment includes:

- At the BSN@Home course review session (January 2018), content specific to healthcare policy was discussed. It was discovered that during the 2014 course revisions, health policy content and associated paper was removed from the 447 Leadership & Management course when the course credits changed from 4 to 3. The lead faculty for this course will review and add information regarding healthcare policy and finance.
- While the curricular changes to increase content coverage regarding healthcare finance and policy have yielded improved results (particularly the employer perspective), we will continue to monitor results of Program Outcome 5 responses on the graduate, alumni and employer surveys.
