

Urban & Regional Studies | 2016-2017 Assessment Report

1. Please give a brief overview of the assessment data you collected this year.

Data from CCQ assessments provided by students to assess learning outcome #2 for the academic program. Specific questions examined pertained to general intellectual development (#2), broadening outlook and perspective (#4), overall course objective achievement (#6) and overall course rating (#7). Only specific courses judged to be most related to the learning objective were used in order to ensure consistency reliability.
