Presentation Remarks

The Recruitment Partner of the Year award is presented annually by Career Services at UW-Green Bay. Each year an organization or a community member is chosen for the recognition based on exceptional commitment to Career Services' mission which includes creating learning opportunities for UW-Green Bay students in their field of study, supporting professional growth and career development of students/alumni and actively involved in recruiting students and alumni for such opportunities.
